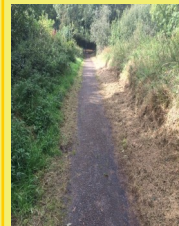

Recently, The Parish Environmental Team (PET) tackled the overgrown verges on the path leading down from Cotswolds Drive to The Town Park, after a number of complaints. The pathway itself was significantly affected by the overgrown verges and foliage.
